



Electric Related Permitting Fees

Electric Meter Connect Fees (Per Meter)

The following electric meter connect fees are applicable to all new services, service relocations, re-builds, upgrades, additions of Distributed Energy Resources (DER), and conversions from overhead to underground and shall be paid by applicant when requesting the electric service to be energized. This is a non-refundable and required fee.

The Electrical Connect Fee is based on the City of Georgetown's cost to provide the meter, the labor to install the meter, the initial inspection of the meter and related metering and engineering system updates.

1. **Single Phase Power:** Fee assessed and payment due prior to any Building Permit being issued. This service will be requested through the Permitting and Inspections Department. Service requested greater than 400 amps will require a line extension application through the Electric Engineering Department.

0-400 amps	\$200 Meter Connect Fee

2. **Commercial Three-Phase:** Fee assessed and payment due prior to any Building Permit being issued. This service will need to be requested through the Electric Engineering department through a line extension application. Meter Connect Fees for multifamily developments and commercial developments shall be billed and collected along with the line extension fees.

Electric Temporary Meter Fees

Per Code of Ordinances Sec. 13.04.210

An Electric temporary meter charge of \$215 will be charged as a part of the permit package to *all applicants*. This fee is to accommodate for the cost of removing and installing a meter from a temporary pole to the building. This is a non-refundable fee.
